

Catechesis is the transmitter of the Faith, which is why it has always been considered by the Church as one of its primary tasks, since the Risen Christ, before returning to the Father, gave his Apostles this last task: to make disciples of all peoples. teaching them to observe all that He had commanded (Mt 28,19)

The ultimate goal of catechesis is to put one not only in contact but in communion, in intimacy with Jesus Christ (CT 5). All evangelizing action must always seek to favor communion with Jesus Christ (GDC 80).

We must never lose sight of the fact that catechesis must help the person being catechized (whether a child, adolescent, youth or adult) achieve a DEEPER INTIMACY IN THE PERSONAL ENCOUNTER WITH JESUS CHRIST, help the person to know and become more and more aware of the need we must have to be close to him, to experience his love, his tenderness.

Our children's catechesis is organized as follows:

1st and 2nd level sacrament of first communion, attending catechism on Thursdays from 6:30-8:00 pm from September-April. It's two years of preparation. We have training in English and Spanish, you choose in which language.

3rd and 4th level sacrament of confirmation by attending catechism on Wednesdays from 6:30-8:00 pm from September-April. It's two years of preparation. We have training in English and Spanish, you choose in which language.

We also have catechism training for parents every 15 days.
